

Early Termination of Lease

1. Resident must give a 60-day written notice to the leasing office.

Ex. If your lease is scheduled to end on June 1st, must give notice by April 1st to avoid additional fees.

- 2. Early termination of your lease will result in loss of all initial deposits that were placed on loft during the application process.
- **3.** An additional one month's rent must be paid as an early termination fee.
- 4. Residents are deemed responsible for any concessions given at the time of leasing.

Ex. Free months rent

5. If you do not notify the leasing office of your lease termination within the 60 days, you will be charged up through 60 days.

Ex. If your lease were to end on June 1st, and you did not submit a notice until May 15th, you will be charged up through July 15th.
